



LUBLIN REGION 2020/21 Tourist Offers

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The Lubelskie Voivodship is a place where you will relax, recuperate and boost your vital strength thanks to close contact with nature. Located in Eastern Poland, the region cultivates agricultural traditions, cares for natural environment and preserves its rich cultural heritage. Visitors to the **Lublin Region appreciate the openness** and friendliness of the inhabitants, a variety of leisure activities and the opportunity to pursue culinary passions. They value the authenticity and uniqueness of areas included in the **UNESCO World Network of Biosphere** Reserves, historical wooden architecture, Lublin Renaissance landmarks, castles, palaces, manors, and unforgettable towns and cities, such as Lublin, Kazimierz Dolny, Puławy, Chełm, Biała Podlaska and Zamość - the UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Nature not only inspires people to discover their inner peace and spend enjoyable time with family and friends but also helps to focus on life priorities and release feel-good emotions. The Lubelskie Voivodship has an impressive natural potential including Poleski and Roztocze National Parks and 17 landscape parks.





Lublin, the capital of the Lubelskie Voivodship, is one of the most attractive cities in Poland, which has been confirmed by declaring it the Polish Tourist Brand. The city boasts a multicultural, over 700-year-long history. The historical architecture of the Old Town that attracts visitors from all over the world is 70 per cent original. For its well-preserved, mainly Renaissance buildings with traces of Gothic, Baroque and Neo-Classicism, Lublin has been awarded the title of the Monument of History by the National Heritage Board of Poland. The most valuable landmarks include the Holy Trinity Royal Chapel, whose walls are covered with 15th-century Russo-Byzantine frescoes, and the Dominican Basilica. Both these historic buildings remember the events of the Polish-Lithuanian Union signed in Lublin in 1569, and have been awarded the European Heritage Label.

Lublin is a city of young and creative people. It is a thriving academic centre based on five state universities and four private colleges. Annual festivals emphasize the atmosphere of openness and respect for culture combined with a modern approach to tradition.

The Night of Culture, Open City, Magicians' Carnival, Jagiellonian Fair, European Festival of Taste, Different Sounds Art'n'Music Festival and the "Codes" Festival of Traditional and Avant-garde Music change the city into a hub of artistic activity. Residents and tourists greatly appreciate and take advantage of the rich offer of numerous museums, contemporary art galleries, theatres, concert halls and cultural institutions. like Centre for the Meeting of Cultures, which present the achievements of world-famous artists. The history of Lublin is closely connected with the Jewish community inhabiting the city from the 15th century to the end of World War II. Hundreds of tourists from Israel visit Lublin to see the relatively few but impressive and important landmarks of Jewish history, such as the Chachmei Yeshiva, historical Jewish cemeteries and the State Museum at Majdanek – a former Nazi concentration camp. The Grodzka Gate - NN Theatre Centre is a municipal cultural institution that documents and preserves the memory of Jewish presence in the Lublin Region. Traces of Jewish heritage can also be seen in the outdoor reconstruction of the 1930s Provincial Town of Central Europe in the Open Air Village Museum in Lublin. The museum is



divided into sectors reflecting the landscape and ethnographic diversification of the Lublin Region: Lublin Upland, Roztocze, Vistula Region, Podlasie and Bug Region, manorial and provincial town sectors. It features collections of wooden and brick architecture as well as ethnographic exhibits dating back to the 17th century. Regular re-enactments of regional customs, traditions and work activities of bygone times are a great chance for museum visitors to participate in these interesting events.

Zamość was founded in the 16th century by Great Crown Hetman Jan Zamoyski and designed as an ideal city by eminent Italian architect Bernardo Morando. This city fortress is an architectural and urban complex listed as the UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1992. Tourists visiting Zamość are always impressed by the picturesque, rectangular, Renaissance market square with beautiful townhouses and the Town Hall, which is decorated with extensive fanshaped double stairs. Zamość is constantly developing its tourist offer by creating new cultural institutions, attractions and museums inside historical buildings, for

example the reconstructed Bastion No. 7 and the Arsenal - Museum of Fortifications and Weapons. Children will also enjoy a trip to Zamość where they can visit the zoo and attractions located in the city park.

The city takes pride in its glorious history and attracts many visitors by organizing historical re-enactments, such as the Storming of Zamość Fortress and the Legend of the Swedish Table, as well as the traditional Hetman Fair. The city's rich musical traditions are cultivated by the Karol Namysłowski Symphony Orchestra - the oldest continuously operating orchestra in Poland.

Chełm, is picturesquely located upon the Uherka River near the state border with Ukraine. The underground Chalk Tunnels are Chełm's most famous and unique tourist attraction and a rarity on a European scale. The labyrinth of corridors winding under the city was created as a result of chalk mining taking place from the 16th to the early 20th century. The underground route is open to visitors. Legend has it that the chalk tunnels are the permanent residence of Bieluch the Ghost. The oldest monuments of Chełm are located on the hill of Górka Chełmska - they are the



remains of a stronghold and a post-Uniate cathedral complex from the 18th century. Architecture and art enthusiasts will definitely enjoy sightseeing the Baroque Church of the Sending of Apostles, designed by famous architect Paweł Fontana, the Orthodox Church of St John the Theologian, the modernist housing estate "Dyrekcja" and rich collections of the Museum of the Chełm Land. The museum houses over 20,000 unique exhibits related to Chełm's history and art, which are presented in the specialized departments of archaeology, history, ethnography, nature, education, art of the Chełm Land, contemporary art and Gallery 72, old photography, archives and library.

Water sports lovers can rest and relax at the Chełm Water Park where, in addition to water attractions, there is an extensive sauna area, squash courts, bowling alleys and many other services.

The capital of Southern Podlasie, **Biała Podlaska** was formerly owned by the aristocratic Radziwiłł Family. The city is primarily associated with the magnificent castle complex from the 17th-18th centuries and the picturesque valley of the Krzna







River, a tributary of the Bug River. Tourists are welcome to the Museum of Southern Podlasie, which features the works of Bazyli Albiczuk and one of the largest collections of Russian icons from the 17th-19th centuries in Poland. Biała Podlaska is a great place for lovers of architecture and history. The most interesting monuments include the restored park and palace complex of the Radziwiłł Family with the 17th-century Entrance Gate. The construction of the gate was commissioned by Katarzyna Radziwiłł née Sobieski, and its façade resembles a triumphal arch. The building of the former Bialska Academy dates from 1628. The Academy prides itself on providing education to many famous people,

including Józef Ignacy Kraszewski and the January Uprising insurgents - Roman Rogiński and priest Stanisław Brzóska. Stefan Żeromski and Julian Ursyn Niemcewicz were also associated with the school. Currently, the former academy houses the J. I. Kraszewski High School.

Another very interesting landmark in Biała Podlaska is St Anne's Church, which was built in 1597-1602, on the foundations of an Arian church. The 1625 chapel of St Jan Kanty is considered one of the most valuable Renaissance works of architectonic art in Podlasie. Well worth visiting are also St Anthony's Church from the 17th century and the Monastery of Friars Minor Capuchin, which dates back to 1687-92.

The Janów Forests is the most extensive forest complex in Poland, which offers an amazing opportunity to observe wild birds and animals, experience the closeness of nature and distance yourself from the noise of civilization. The most recommended tourist sites include: the Imielty Ług nature reserve, Porytowe Wzgórze, where the largest partisan battle of World War II took place, the Szklarnia reserve located near Janów Lubelski, where a refuge of the Biłgoraj horse was created, and the Arboretum, which is an attractive location for Nordic walking, jogging or spending free time.

A great introduction to the Janów Forests is a visit to the "Zoom Natury" Recreational Park, which is a large educational and leisure complex by the Janów Reservoir. The resort offers a range of attractions: a beautiful sandy beach, rope park, observation tower, walking alleys, fountains, cycle paths, outdoor gyms, and modern educational laboratories

providing an incentive to discover the surrounding nature.

Janów Lubelski is a town situated by the Janów Forests. Tourists can visit the Marian sanctuary with a church and Dominican monastery from 1694-1720 funded by the Zamoyski Family. There is also the Forest Narrow Gauge Railway Museum and one of the first monuments of Tadeusz Kościuszko, which was erected in 1818

The best way to discover **the Łuków Land** is by bike. A 330-kilometre network of bicycle routes will be an excellent attraction for fans of active tourism seeking an alternative to spending time in a crowded city.

The historical capital of this region is Łuków. The town boasts two 18th-century Baroque church and monastery complexes of the post--Bernardine and Piarist Orders. Presently, parts of the monastery buildings are home to the Regional Museum and its impressive ethnographic, geological and archaeological collections. Nearby Stoczek Łukowski, surrounded by forests and picturesquely located on the Świder River, became famous for the first victorious battle of the Polish army in the November Uprising. This event is commemorated by a monument from 1931 erected on the 100th anniversary of this victory. A must-see place is Wola Okrzejska, the place where the Polish Nobel Prize winner Henryk Sienkiewicz was born. The local museum has an extensive collection of the writer's family photographs, personal memorabilia as well as a unique anthology of the first editions of his works. The next interesting stop on our sightseeing

The next interesting stop on our sightseeing tour is Wola Gułowska, where the sanctuary of Our Lady, the Patron Saint of Polish Soldiers of the September Campaign is located. This



is one of the largest Baroque churches in the region, dating from the turn of the 18th century. At the parish cemetery there is a grave of soldiers from General Kleeberg's "Polesie" Independent Operational Group who died during the Battle of Kock (3-5 October 1939), fought near Wola Gułowska. Memorabilia and information connected with the battle can be seen at the local Museum of Combat Action of Kleeberg's Soldiers.



The Multicultural Current of the Bug

River is a land where cultures and borders meet, and where the traditions of Orthodoxy, Catholicism and Judaism merge. Unique cultural events complement the multitude of religious monuments, sanctuaries and historical landmarks. Restored manor houses offer tourists an opportunity for rest and relaxation far away from stressful civilization. Fresh air, lush greenery, magical Polesie landscapes, cultural festivals, painting locations and unspoilt nature are the main assets of

the Bug River area, which will undoubtedly be appreciated by tourists seeking peace and quiet and close contact with nature.

Włodawa is the best starting point of a journey along the route of the Multicultural Current of the Bug River. The town is situated in the Polesie Region, by the state border with Belarus. It is called "the town of three cultures" because believers of three denominations. - Catholicism, Judaism and Orthodoxy - coexisted there for centuries. A testimony to this multi-religious past is the location of the three main temples - the Synagogue Complex, the late Baroque St Ludwig's Church with the Pauline monastery, and the Orthodox church of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary - on the neighbouring streets. Since 1995 Włodawa has hosted the Festival of Three Cultures. This is an unusual event connecting the past of this small borderland town with its present, which implements an ecumenical programme of protection, education and promotion of the local tradition of diversity, tolerance and coexistence of cultures.

The offer of nature tourism is uniquely complemented by the Land Art Festival, during which outdoor land art projects are



introduced into the fabric of landscape and coexist with aesthetic and artistic values of natural space. Organized by the Latajaca Ryba Foundation, the festival realises the concept of moving art beyond museums, galleries and large urban economic centres. These land art activities are part of a global trend of ecological visual art in the structure of natural environment.

Tourists who value a healthy lifestyle, active leisure, canoeing and other sports can take advantage of the offer of active recreation. An unforgettable experience will be provided by kayaking on the Bug River, which is the border of the European Union, and by riding a bicycle along the Green Velo - East of Poland Cycling Trail.

The Multicultural Current of the Bug River is a destination that will help restore health and wellbeing of the most demanding travellers. A stay in the enchanting guesthouse "Uroczysko Zaborek", which combines a historical charm of old traditional buildings with high hotel standards, guarantees a comfortable rest in harmony with nature. High quality services are offered by the four-star hotel, Zamek Biskupi in Janów Podlaski, which is situated in the vicinity of the world-famous Arabian Horse Stud.













The Land of Loess Gorges, honoured with the Polish Tourist Brand title, is one of the most interesting touristic regions in Poland. Charming landscapes, valuable natural areas, unique loess gorges, intere-

sting architecture, and a visible respect for tradition all create a perfect scenery for rest and leisure. The visitors appreciate health values and professionally prepared offer of Nałęczów, amazing cuisine based on ecological local products, and a possibility to relax away from noisy cities. The area is interspersed with numerous tourist trails perfect for walking, cycling, Nordic walking or horse riding. Enthusiasts of active tourism can enjoy kayaking to the most picturesque parts of the Małopolski Gorge of the Vistula River.

One of the most popular tourist destinations in Poland is Kazimierz Dolny, located within the Land of Loess Gorges. It owes its attractiveness to glorious Renaissance architecture, the Vistula River, the vicinity of scenic loess gorges, and an artistic vibe. It has become a perfect location for open-air painting and photography sessions, and a meeting place for local craftsmen. The town hosts popular festivals, such as the National Festival of Folk Bands and Singers, "Two Riversides" Film and Art Festival, and the music festival "Kazimiernikejszyn". When in Kazimierz Dolny you must visit the Goldsmith Museum (a branch of the Nadwiślańskie Museum), Parish church, ruins of the castle, as well as take a long hike through the loess ravines and taste the famous local rooster-shaped bread. The Land of Loess Gorges has a vast offer for people interested in culture, art and architecture. It is worth paying a visit to the Czartoryski Museum in Puławy and its surrounding beautiful park, St. Florian and St. Catherine's church in Gołąb, Sanctuary of Our Lady in Wawolnica, historical churches in Końskowola, the Museum of Blacksmithery and the smithy in Wojciechów, the

Museums of Stefan Żeromski and Bolesław Prus in Nałęczów, and many other lesser known yet very attractive places.

The Zamouski Museum in Kozłówka is

one of the best preserved park and palace complexes in Europe and holds the title of the Monument of History. The late-Baroque magnate residence once belonged to the aristocratic families of Bieliński and Zamovski. Inside the palace, visitors can admire beautiful interior décor with stylish furniture, impressive paintings and everyday objects dating back to previous centuries. It is also worth visiting the chapel from the beginning of the 20th century modelled on the royal chapel at the Palace of Versailles. In 1994 the former coach-house became home to the Socialist-Realist Art Gallery exhibiting paintings, sculptures, and other works of Polish Socialist Realism.







Polesie. Poleski National Park is a unique place, filled with tranquillity and sounds of nature. The Didactic Centre and Museum in Stare Załucze, where exhibitions about nature, culture and history of Western Polesie are presented, is a perfect introduction to a visit to the park. The biodiversity of the area and the number of protected species of plants and animals that are found there is truly remarkable. The park is a refuge of the black grouse, black stork, wolf, ermine and the extremely rare European pond turtle. The institution has been successfully implementing a special protection programme for this endangered species since 1998. Poleski National Park is the best place for long walks along forest tracks and wooden footbridges running through the marshes and allowing tourists to safely reach previously inaccessible areas. All the educational paths, such as Spławy, Czahary or Perehod,

are professionally prepared. Cycling in the park is also a pleasant way of spending time in close contact with nature. Many bicycle routes lead through attractive areas in the immediate vicinity of the park, namely the Łęczna-Włodawa Lake District. This land of lakes, forests and streams is a favourite destination of holidaymakers, water sports enthusiasts and anglers who love fishing in the lakes and the meandering Bug River.

Roztocze. Situated in the southern part of the Lublin Region, Roztocze National Park impresses visitors with its natural diversity and attractive offer of leisure activities. The starting point of a sightseeing tour should be Zwierzyniec, where the head office and the Educational Centre and Museum of Roztocze National Park are located. It is worth seeing interesting exhibitions, temporary presentations and educational games displayed around the main building because they provide an informative introduction to discovering the natural treasures of the Lublin Region. The town of Zwierzyniec is a charming place with a picturesque Baroque church of St John of Nepomuk and a well-preserved complex of management buildings of the Zamoyski Estate and the House of the Plenipotentiary. There is also a 19th-century brewery, which is open to the public and still cultivates brewing traditions.

Another enjoyable activity is strolling to the Echo Ponds where you can peacefully relax on a sandy beach surrounded by water and a beautiful forested landscape. Thanks to the viewing platforms located in the park, you can observe a semi-wild herd of the rare breed of the Polish horse, a descendant of the tarpan. The Forest Chamber and the Polish





horse Breeding Centre in Florianka are also worth visiting.

Roztocze offers perfect conditions for active tourism and engaging in such activities as kayaking, hiking, Nordic walking and cycling. "Green Velo" and the Central Bicycle Trail of Roztocze are examples of well-prepared bicycle routes that lead through this picturesque land.

Last but not least, Lubelskie Voivodship is known for its **regional cuisine** based natural ingredients and traditional recipes. You can try the most known Lublin specialties such as onion bread or buckwheat groats pies, and many other ecological locally-made meat products, cheeses, beers, meads and liquors. The unforgettable taste of regional cuisine combined with scenic vistas and local hospitality will encourage you to frequently visit the Lublin Region.



Janów Lubelski | Zoom of nature

The "Zoom Natury" Recreational Park is a great place to get to know the natural world through active experience, adventure and experimentation. Enthusiasts of outdoor fun and games will thoroughly enjoy such attractions as an energy square with fountains, a rope park, an outdoor gym, a mysterious exit room, the Water Park and the Creative Park.

ACCOMMODATION:

The "ALMATUR" Holiday Resort is located in a forest by the Janów Reservoir, approx. 200 m from clean sandy beaches and guarded swimming areas. The premises are fenced and monitored. The resort has a tennis court, beach volleyball court, bicycle rental, climbing wall, tourist train, playground, campfire spot, sauna, Jacuzzi and WI-FI Internet access.

All participants can take part in two excursions: a trip around the area - to the old pottery workshop in Łążek Garncarski, Porytowe Wzgórze, Momoty and Szklarnia - by a narrow gauge tourist train or coach, and a coach trip to a selected destination: Zamość, Łańcut, Sandomierz, or Lublin.

The resort offers a wide range of sports activities: table tennis, badminton, beach volleyball, hiking, cycling, campfires, quests, sports Olympics, discos, karaoke, and other outdoor and indoor games.

In addition to these attractions, each group implements its own individual camp programme.






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
